

# DR. JAMES EARL KENNAMER Academic Scholarship Program APPLICANT INFORMATION

## Purpose

The purpose of the NWTF Dr. James Earl Kennamer Academic Scholarship Program is to recognize and reward NWTF JAKES members, who are currently seniors in high school, for their outstanding academic achievements, community involvement and leadership roles.

## Award Levels

There are three award levels for this scholarship program:

- Local Chapter Scholarship (\$250 minimum)
- State Chapter Scholarship (\$1,000 minimum)
- National Scholarship (\$10,000, Sponsored by Mossy Oak®)

\*Minimum scholarship totals may vary based on the chapter.

## Availability

Local chapter and state chapter scholarships are contingent upon individual chapter participants. To find out if your local NWTF chapter is participating, contact your NWTF regional director by using the “find a chapter” tool at NWTF.org.

## Selection Process

1. High schools/students will submit applicant names and qualifications on an official NWTF scholarship application, along with required attachments, to the local chapter by Jan. 1.
2. Local chapters will forward winners to the state chapter president by Feb. 1.
3. State officers will forward state winners to NWTF headquarters by March 1, where the NWTF Scholarship Committee will select the national winner.
4. Winners may not be notified until their high school awards banquet.  
The national winner will be asked to attend the NWTF National Convention the following year to be recognized.
